If a property is owned by a trust, the trustee is a GVR member unless otherwise designated in the trust. An Assigned Member is an individual who occupies a GVR Property without paying rent and has been assigned membership rights by the owner(s) of such property. A candidate must be in good standing with GVR at the time of his/her nomination.
