- 1. What do you think are the characteristics of a great board member? Professional behavior, even temperament, respectful, attentive to other ideas. Understanding of the rules by which GVR is governed, i.e., policy governance.

- 5. Is there something the current Board is doing or not doing that you would handle differently?

Much time and money may be wasted for this, and for future expansion projects for various club interests. I find this unacceptable, and will work hard to restore the fracture that has been created.
