#### Annual Agreement to Retain GVR "Club Status"

The Mission Statement of GVR: "To provide recreational, social and leisure education opportunities that enhance the quality of our members' lives."

We, The Correction of the Correction of the Club Status," liability insurance coverage, essential storage, custodial and maintenance services, basic utilities, and to receive priority reservations over all other GVR groups and staff, we agree to sign and submit this Annual Club Agreement, which outlines our Club's responsibilities to GVR in order to receive the above listed benefits from GVR in return.

We, the Hunt My Club verify that all members of our Club are members of GVR. We understand Club membership shall be open to all members of GVR who shall be entitled to participate in any meeting or activity. We have maintained and will be able to maintain at least twenty-five (25) active members in our Club to retain our "Club Status." We understand if we fall below the minimum of twenty-five (25) active members we will need to increase our membership or we will jeopardize our "Club Status." We understand if it is determined that there is a fifty-percent (50%) or more cross-over in membership in two or more clubs; we will be consolidated into another group at GVR's discretion. The room capacity may limit participation of club activities. Where advanced skills or special qualifications might limit membership in certain clubs, we will offer training, orientation, or instruction for new members. We will not affiliate with any national, state, or regional organization that requires GVR members to join its external organization. We may grant guest privileges at our own discretion, as long as they are eligible guests in accordance with GVR Policies. We will not grant honorary membership, or the equivalent, to a non-GVR member. We will not allow guests to regularly participate in our club activities. We agree to execute an effective monitoring system to ensure that only GVR members and eligible guests are in attendance at our meetings and activities of the club.

It shall be the responsibility of our Club to furnish necessary insurance on any equipment not owned by GVR and brought onto GVR premises; e.g., musical instruments, tape players, computers, radios, etc. We have and will continue to operate under a nonprofit status consistent with IRS tax Code 501(c) 4. We have secured an IRS Employer Identification Number (EIN) and have provided the number to GVR. We understand that we are responsible for any local, state, or federal taxes incurred because of our activities. We have maintained and will maintain a simple bookkeeping system recording all income, sources of income, and expenditures. Receipts for expenditures are to be kept for a period of no less than seven (7) years in the event of an audit. We agree to file a simple financial statement indicating cash on hand and a plan for its future expenditure.

We have utilized and will utilize at least fifty percent (50%) of our assigned space at all times. We understand GVR has the option of reassigning our Club to another facility, combining the Club with another of similar interest, or releasing the Club from "Club Status" if deemed appropriate. We are self-supporting in movable equipment and operating supplies unique to the club and we are responsible for repair and replacement of such equipment at the club's expense. The Club understands that all equipment belongs to GVR, whether it is the original equipment, replacement of original equipment, or additional equipment subsequently purchased by the club. Equipment includes machines, computers, furniture, machine tools, building fixtures, building improvements, carpeting, and kilns. The Club understands it does not have the authority to lend or borrow any equipment or supplies that are classified as GVR property. We understand specialized equipment, to meet the needs or desires of a Club, will not be financially supported by GVR dues or other income.

We will obtain GVR approval before the installation of any equipment or any rearrangement that may affer floors, walls, air conditioning, electrical equipment, or additional consumption of gas and electricity. Outside costs incurred for installation or relocation of equipment will be charged to the Club. The Club understands GV will provide essential storage for GVR Clubs at no cost, on a space-available only basis. We further understant we may store only those items, which are critical to our ongoing needs. Storage of perishable foods, liquor, an highly flammable material is prohibited. We understand GVR does not assume custody of any property in storage and is not responsible for any loss or damage thereto.

The Club understands and agrees that facilities will not be guaranteed each year and are based on space availability. A "tentative" copy of your regularly scheduled reservations will be given to you the day of the Annual Club Workshop for your review. A signed copy must be returned to the reservations coordinator with two (2) weeks. We agree to designate only one (1) Club contact person to schedule Club reservations. The Club understands that reservations by unauthorized Club members will be denied.

The Club agrees each year to submit a completed membership roster (including the names, addresses, ar membership numbers of current and new members), a financial statement of the previous year, an officers list copy of IRS E-postcard/990 EZ form, and an equipment/storage inventory list. We have maintained and we maintain a continuity of records and shall preserve all correspondence and minutes for a period of no less that four years.

We understand the sale of intoxicating beverages is not permitted on GVR premises without a state issued lique permit; however, we are permitted to bring our own beverages upon approval by GVR Administration.

The Club understands that we risk revocation of our "Club Status" should we knowingly violate GVR Rules are Regulations governing the operations of Clubs and/or facility use regulations as set forth by GVR. A complete copy of the GVR Corporate Policy Manual is available on the GVR web site.

The Club has read and understands this Agreement to retain our "Club Status."

# BYLAWS for the

#### **GVR HUNTING AND FISHING CLUB**

#### **ARTICLE I - Name**

The official name of the organization shall be the GVR Hunting and Fishing Club, hereinafter known as the Club.

## ARTICLE II - Purpose

The primary purpose of the Club shall be to provide an opportunity for any GVR member living within the GVR boundaries to meet socially to learn more about fishing and hunting opportunities in Arizona and to share their hunting, fishing and shooting experiences.

All activities conducted by the Club and its members shall be in accordance with the GVR Bylaws, Corporate Policy Manual and GVR Code of Conduct.

#### **ARTICLE III - Membership**

- A. All members holding GVR membership or tenant cards in good standing with GVR are entitled to join and participate in any meeting or activity, until the maximum capacity of a facility being used is reached. Membership shall not be denied to GVR members in good standing.
- B. Any member who has not paid dues, fees or assessments to GVR or the Club as of the time such payment becomes delinquent shall be removed from the Club's roster.
- C. For the safety of users and the protection of GVR property, proficiency training or demonstration of proficiency may be required by the Club membership.
- D. The Club shall not grant honorary membership or the equivalent to anyone NOT a GVR member.
- E. Guest policies and guest cards are privileges extended to GVR members to use all GVR facilities subject to the current rules and regulations put forth through Board policy and as defined in the GVR Bylaws.
  - F. A GVR member may attend a Club activity one time prior to joining the Club.
- G. All members and guests shall abide by the published GVR Rules and Regulations and the member Code of Conduct. Violations will jeopardize the privileges of the

offending individual through removal from the Club's membership roster and/or possible GVR suspension procedures.

#### **ARTICLE IV - Board of Directors**

A. The governing body shall consist of five Directors who are elected by the current members. The Board shall: enforce the Club's Rules and Regulations, the Club's Bylaws, GVR Bylaws, the GVR Corporate Policy Manual and GVR Club Rules and Regulations; handle the general supervision of the affairs of the Club between Annual meetings; fix the hour and place of the Annual meeting and make recommendations to the membership and perform other duties as desired by the Club.

- B. The Officers of the Club shall consist of a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer and shall be elected by a majority vote of the members in attendance at the Annual Meeting. The Officers shall perform duties as prescribed by these Bylaws and by the parliamentary authority adopted by this Club. The Secretary and Treasurer may or may not also be Directors.
- C. The imterim Directors and Officers of the Club shall be determined in any manner necessary to establish the Club and shall serve until the first Annual Meeting. Thereafter the term of each Director shall be for no more than three years starting at the close of the Annual meeting at which they were elected. The first Board of Directors to be elected shall be composed of two members serving a one year term, two members serving a two year term and one member serving a three year term, each term being in addition to the partial term from date of organization to the first Annual meeting. When terms of different length are to be filled, these receiving the highest number of votes shall be elected to the longer terms. No Director shall serve more than two consecutive terms. All elections shall take place at the Annual Meeting and shall be by closed ballot. Nominations for election to the Board of Directors may be made by any member in attendance at the Annual meeting.

#### D. Responsibilities of Officers:

<u>President</u>- The President shall preside at all meetings of the Club and shall carry out all orders and resolutions of the Club. The President shall be the executor of all Club funds and may approve all individual expenditures up to \$100.00. Expenditures over and above this amount must be approved by a quorum of the Board of Directors. (See last paragraph in this section for Board quorum).

<u>Vice President</u>- In the absence of the President, the Vice President shall perform all duties of the President and when so acting shall have all powers of the President.

<u>Secretary- Prepares minutes of the Annual Meeting.</u> Must retain routine correspondence and other administrative records for three years prior to the current year. Certain permanent records such as membership lists, year end financial statement, Employer Identification Number, tax exemption, etc. shall be retained for the life of the Club. The President shall sign all formal written communications.

<u>Treasurer</u>- Makes all authorized disbursements, records and deposits in the bank accounts all monies of the Club, prepares a current financial report for the Annual Meeting, prepares a fiscal year end financial report on an annual basis and has books, records and papers available upon request of any member.

E. A quorum for transaction of business at a Board meeting shall be three (3) directors.

#### ARTICLE V - Committees

A. The President, with the approval of the Club's Board of Directors shall appoint any Committee deemed necessary.

#### ARTICLE VI - Membership Meetings

- A. The Club's Annual Meeting shall be during the month of January of each fiscal year.
- B. Notice of the Annual Meeting shall be made by mail at least fourteen days in advance of the meeting and shall set forth, specifically, the nature of the business to be transacted.
- C. A quorum for transaction of business at the Annual Meeting shall be one-tenth or 10% of the entire membership in good standing.
- D. Robert's Rules of Order shall govern the Club in all cases in which they are applicable and in which they are not inconsistent with the Club's Bylaws or any special rules of order the Club may adopt.

#### **ARTICLE VII - Dues and Fiscal Period**

- A. The fiscal year shall be February1through January 31. The Club shall prepare a year end financial statement within 30 days following close of the fiscal year. Such statement shall be available to all members at any reasonable time.
- B. The Board of Directors shall recommend an annual budget with final approval from the general membership at the Annual Meeting.
- C. Dues for charter members shall be due within 30 days of establishment of the club. Hereafter, dues for renewing members shall be due on February 1. Dues for new members joining after the beginning of the fiscal year shall be due when they attend their first meeting. Non-payment of dues shall result in removal of the member's name from the Club's membership roster.

#### **ARTICLE VIII - Vacancies**

The Vice President shall perform the duties and exercise the powers of the President

during absence or disability. If any other vacancy should occur, the remainder of the term shall be filled by appointment by the President with approval from the Board of Directors.

#### **ARTICLE IX - Amendments**

The Board of Directors of the Club may make amendments to these Bylaws with a majority affirmative vote of the membership. The Club must submit any amendments proposed to GVR staff for approval, prior to adoption.

#### **ARTICLE X - Monitoring**

An effective monitoring system shall be maintained by Club Officers to ensure that <u>only</u> club members and <u>eligible</u> guests are in attendance at meetings and activities of the Club. All participants shall register on a log sheet provided by GVR each time they attend any meeting, program or activity. Monitors at GVR serve as host/hostess to members, guests and visitors. As such they are empowered to enforce <u>all</u> Club and <u>all</u> GVR rules and regulations.

#### **ARTICLE XI - Dissolution**

Upon dissolution of the Club all assets, after all bills are paid, shall be transferred to GVR.

#### **ARTICLE XII - Bylaws**

A copy of these approved Bylaws shall be available to the general membership at the Annual Meeting. All elected Officers and Committee Chairpersons shall be furnished with a copy of the GVR Bylaws and the current approved Club Bylaws after each election.
