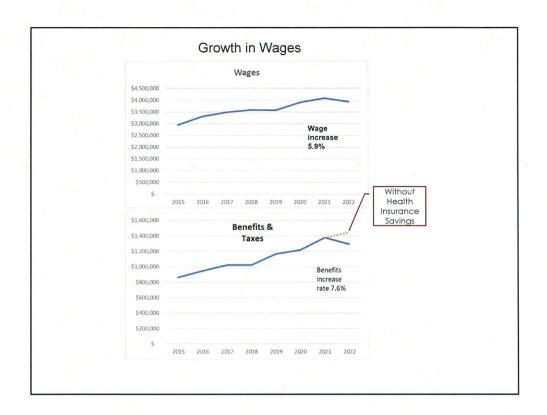
Presentation: Personnel Cost



The following Personnel Costs analysis is in response to our CEO request to provide a high level overview of long term and short term growth in Personnel costs with the goal of obtaining an accurate understanding of whether the Personnel costs are reasonable and supported by the level of revenue generated by GVR..



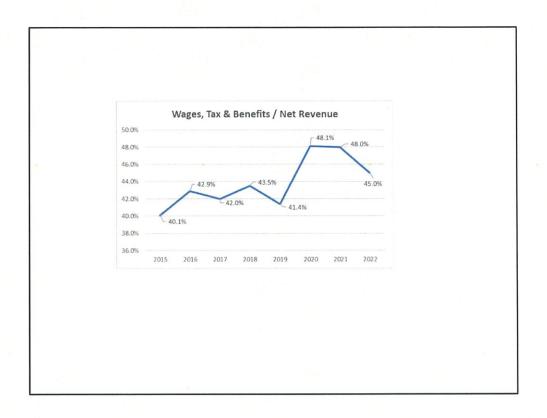
Over the past 7 years, the average annual growth in revenue has been 4.1% compared to a 5.0% annual growth rate in Personnel costs. While the difference seems to be a small number, the Personnel costs growth are 22% more than the growth in Revenue. It is important to note that the past 3 years, the growth in Personnel costs declined to 3.4%. The trend is in the right direction.



These 7 year trend graphs breaks down the total Personnel costs into Wages versus Taxes and Benefits. You can see that Benefits have outpaced Wages. Also, you can see with the dashed line that GVR was able reduce this trend by changing our health insurance provider and some revisions to our benefits plan.

This slide shows the total increase in Personnel and Total GVR Expenses, not average annual increases. You can see that the rate of growth is diminishing during the past 3 years. With continued work on both the wages and benefits components side of this equation. We believe that the current trend in Personnel Costs are moving in the right direction.



When comparing personnel costs to revenue, it is best to use Net Revenue. Revenue that does not include Investment Income or loss best measures GVR's Operating Income. The Personnel costs compared to this Net Income is trending downward.

- Desert Hills Fitness Center is on schedule. The project will be finished and the
 equipment will be delivered in May. A ribbon cutting will be scheduled for May, but
 possibly June.
- Glass Arts Studio space has begun demolition, using GVR staff to keep the cost down.
 There will be a "ground breaking/wall smashing" event this evening with the Board being invited, along with contractors and others. Great opportunity to celebrate this project moving forward.
- Ceramics Arts Studio design expansion is underway with the architect working on the final designs and development of the construction documents. The construction documents and cost estimates will be brought to the Board when completed to get Board direction.
- Del Sol Clubhouse architectural designs for the upper and lower levels have been submitted to staff. Site work: the parking lot and driveways, and the tile work in the bathrooms all are underway. Once the bathrooms are done the temporary porta potties will be removed. The upper level of Del Sol Clubhouse is being used and GVR has received great feedback from members who are enjoying the Clubhouse.
- Woodshop designs are being drafted by the architect and their mechanical engineer. This was approved as part of the 2023 Club Funding Requests.

Accept the Green Valley Recreation, Incorporated (GVR) 2022 Surplus Calculation and approve a transfer from Operating Cash to Initiatives in the amount of \$428,596.

Strategic Plan Goal:

Goal 4: Cultivate and maintain a sound financial base that generates good value for our members.

Background Justification:

Green Valley Recreation's Surplus Policy is stated in Section 3 – Reserve Policy Part 5.3.2 Part C. entitled **Calculation of Operating Surplus or Deficit.** This policy was updated and approved by the Board of Directors in 2021. The 2022 financial statements have been audited and GVR staff have prepared a surplus calculation for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2022. The amount of the 2022 Surplus is \$428,596.

Fiscal Impact:

The intent of the surplus calculation is to determine if there is a surplus of operating revenue over operating expenses each year that can be transferred to a reserve fund. Approving a transfer of \$428,596 will reduce Operating Cash and increase the Initiatives fund by \$428,596. An estimate of \$400,000 was previously included in the Cash Requirements report for 2023 and the Capital Plan projection for 2023. GVR has sufficient Operating Cash to incur this transfer.

A copy of the updated Capital Plan is included to illustrate that the Initiatives Fund is the appropriate account to deposit the Surplus into. With this \$428,596 transfer, the projected end of year balance of the Initiative Fund is \$446,272.

Board Options:

- 1. Approve the \$428,596 2022 Surplus transfer out of Operating Cash into the Initiatives Fund.
- 2. Not approve any transfer for the 2022 Surplus.
- 3. Approve an alternative to transferring the 2022 Surplus.

IT Department in collaboration with the office of the COO and the Facilities Director.

Action Requested:

Award contract to Preventronics for security camera provision and installation, not to exceed \$200,000, and authorize the President to sign the contract.

Strategic Plan Goal:

Goal 1: Provide excellent facilities for members to participate in a variety of active and social opportunities.

Background Justification:

Security concerns have thankfully not been a historical concern at GVR. However, it is a different time than before, and with a recent intrusion at Las Campanas, staff and others agree that increased security is needed to ensure a safer environment for all GVR members, guest, and visitors. Security cameras placed in strategic locations (e.g., parking lots, points of entry, walkways) can help deter nefarious activity as well as help provide evidence during an investigation and Code of Conduct allegations.

Staff issued a request for proposals (RFP) and received bids from three vendors: Preventronics, Titan Alarm, and Johnson Controls for security cameras covering 14 centers, the Administrative Office, the Pickleball Center, the Del Sol Clubhouse, and the Facility Maintenance Building. Staff also priced similar cameras with a well-known online vendor, Verkada. After meeting with each local company and explaining the scope of work, each of the three local companies submitted bids. Verkada's pricing for the cameras alone (less labor, less misc. switching and cabling, less yearly licensing) was much more costly and dropped from consideration.

Preventronics is GVR's current vendor for all DSX access control systems that operate all of the doors and gates. Their staff is familiar with every center throughout the campus and the needs and expectations of the GVR community.

Staff therefore recommends awarding a contract to Preventronics for security camera provision and installation, not to exceed \$200,000. While the contract price is for \$153.729, staff recommends allowing for additional contingency to cover unexpected costs or additional cameras should the need be warranted without the need to come back to the Board recommending a change order.

Fiscal Impact:

This capital expense was not budgeted. Staff recommends funds for this project be expended from the Initiatives Funds. Annual cost to maintain this system is \$15,373 and would be budgeted as an operational expense going forward. Maintenance includes:

- 4-hour service response time between 6am-6pm, M-F.
- Top priority service calls.
- Bi-annual inspections of all hardware/software and database maintenance.
- Software upgrades as necessary.
- All parts. (1 years)
- All labor. (1 years)
- Use of spare equipment to minimize downtime.

Board Options:

- 1. Approve the GVR staff recommended contract with Preventronics to install cameras at all facilities in strategic locations at a cost not to exceed \$200,000, and authorize the President to sign the contract.
- 2. Approve the GVR staff recommended contract with Preventronics to install cameras at all facilities in strategic locations at a cost not to exceed a different amount, and authorize the President to sign the contract.
- 3. Direct staff to pursue less expensive options with fewer cameras, not to exceed a certain limit.
- 4. Direct staff to do nothing with cameras at this time.

Move to Award contract to Preventronics for security camera provision and installation, not to exceed \$200,000, and authorize the President to sign the contract.
