#### **CLUB CONTRIBUTION POLICY**

### MOTION: Campfield / Seconded. I move that

- 1. Financial assistance in amounts under \$5,000 may be given to GVR clubs as part of each fiscal year's budget process if funds are available as determined by the Fiscal Affairs Committee:
- 2. P&E Committee will determine the amount of club awards;
- 3. GVR clubs applying for financial awards do so through the Club Awards Application which is submitted to the club liaison and forwarded to the P&E Committee;
- 4. GVR clubs are expected to contribute a nominal 10% to all projects with the exception of those related to Health, Safety and ADA Compliance; and
- 5. Appropriate changes will be made to the Corporate Policy Manual (CPM) and Annual Club Agreement to reflect this policy.

### MOTION: Campfield / Seconded. I move that

- 1. GVR clubs may request Capital Projects in excess of \$5,000 by applying to the P&E Committee;
- 2. Such requests will be considered by the P&E Committee and if approved by the GVR Board will be added to the current 3-Year Strategic Plan or 10-Year Strategic Plan as appropriate and if funds are available as determined by the Fiscal Affairs Committee.
